Presentations

A participant can prepare 1 oral presentation and/or 1 poster. The presentation should not exceed 15 min.

Preparation of posters

Poster dimensions should be 70 (width) $\times 100$ (height) cm, in English.

Publication

- Privileged communications, presented during session, in an original research paper form after acceptance can be published in the journal "Food. Science. Technology. Quality.".
- Original research paper should be prepared according to the requirements of the journal "Food. Science. Technology. Quality.".
- The rest original research papers after acceptance can be published in a monograph.
- All abstracts will be published in a book of abstracts.

<u>Desiderata to the Conference of Young Researchers Section of</u> <u>Polish Society of Food Technologists' regulation</u>

- 1. Participants of the 17th Conference of Young Researchers Section should be PhD students, young researchers who are not independent researchers.
- 2. The Organizing Committee sets the chairmen of debates and they come from all institutions universities, research center, etc.
- 3. Only young researchers participants of the conference should be the authors of posters, announcements (there should be a piece of information, under whose direction the work was done, at the end of the poster or announcement).
- 4. There should be extra information if the work was prepared thanks to a supervisor's grant.
- A supervisor or a research team should be co author(s) of an announced conference publication – research papers are published in the same form like last years.
- 6. The presence of a participant next to a poster during the poster session is obligatory.
- 7. The Scientific Committee evaluates posters and oral presentations and confers distinctions in both category.
- 8. All young researchers Conference's participants also evaluate posters and oral presentation; they confer distinctions by voting in both category too.

9. The Organizing Committee of the Conference of Young Researchers Section consist of representatives from the universities with doctoral studies.
